

Conclude the demolition of the old promenade to the Cícer to end the gap and gain 2,500 meters of beach

The Urbanismo area of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria has concluded the collapse phase of the old 110-meter section of Las Canteras promenade located next to the new Cícer footbridge.

The process of demolishing the two squares of the old 12-meter-high car park, which began last May, using two back-excavators with hydraulic jaws, has almost concluded, once all the debris has been removed, Small part of the parking located at the foot of the beach.

Councilor for Urban Planning, Javier Doreste, has stated that "once the demolition of this horrible mound has never been built, without having affected, by the way, the passage of pedestrians along the walk, we continue with the project of creation of New catwalk of the Cícer within the deadlines that we had marked ".

"If everything goes so far, we estimate that the neighbors will be able to launch next November a space so important for the city, that they use hundreds of neighbors daily. The new walkway of the Cícer will not only greatly improve the physiognomy of this part of the capital's coast, we will also gain 2,500 square meters of beach for the citizens' enjoyment, "said Doreste.

The City Council has also removed part of the fence of work located next to California Street, which was installed due to the works to match the current walk to the same level of the new viaduct, thus facilitating that the terraces of the area have resumed their normal activity .

The project to create the new Cícer footbridge continues with the start of the construction of the ramps from the walk to the beach, which has begun in the area next to California Street. Due to the closure of the Cruz Roja facilities as a result of the construction, the Ciudad de Mar area maintains the facilities of the spa and the Red Cross on the Las Canteras promenade along Calle Calletana Manrique to ensure continuity of service.

This second phase of the project contemplates, besides the demolition of the old walkway between Pizarro and California streets, the construction of a public square, the installation of two escalators, a staircase and two adapted ramps that will join the walk with the beach and the Burial of the power plant located at one end of the promenade.

A total of 29 companies presented themselves to the bidding process commissioned by the Town Planning area of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria to the Municipal Society of Urban Management (GEURSA), which was awarded to the company Satocan, to carry out the Construction of the footbridge of La Cícer. The project to reorganize the Las Canteras promenade in La Cícer, which occupies a total area of 9,821 square meters, represents an investment of 3,606,707 euros.
