For many, El Economista adds, it is one of the best urban beaches in the world".

This classification of beaches suitable for families with small children was published last August 24. Just a couple of months after the portal Playea highlighted Las Canteras as the best family beach in Spain, in a news also highlighted by the portal specialized in tourism Expreso.
