Among the ten best beaches in Spain ... and among the most important beaches in the Canary Islands. Both the sports newspaper As and the Spanish-language portal of National Geographic certify the attractiveness of the iconic Las Palmas de Gran Canaria beach for visitors. Both publications broadcast on these dates two articles in which Las Canteras is not missing.

These summer references in two of the main specialized headings, National Geographic in nature, science, travel and adventures, and the daily AS in sports information, encourage travelers to visit the city and one of its best known tourist icons. In this sense, Tourism of the city council of the capital has focused its efforts in the first half of the year to promote the capital and capture the holiday public in which has traditionally been its offseason, summer.

National Geographic stops at a dozen essential beaches on the map of the Archipelago, in an article entitled "The best beaches in Canary Islands". The photo of a surfer in the evening of La Cícer illustrates the commentary of this reference portal, which emphasizes how "more than a beach, an icon. For its part, the sports newspaper AS disseminates in its web edition the article entitled "The 10 best beaches in Spain", which also refers to Las Canteras, taking as a reference the ranking of Trip Advisor, "made among users of all the nationalities".

De Las Canteras stresses that it is "the fourth of the Spanish list and the number 14 at European level". And he adds that the "principal urban arenal main Las Palmas de Gran Canaria" is not only one of the beaches that "can be enjoyed all year round thanks to the warm climate of the island", but also "it is a great reserve Marine".
