From a rescue demonstration for the practice of surfing by the students of the aquatic lifeguards course of the Training Program in Alternation with the Employment of Arucas, to the exhibition related to the marine environment in Playa del Burrero in Ingenio are part of the varied Proposals that can be enjoyed during the weekend.

The southern municipality of Mogán promotes fishing activity and offers gastronomic tastings with recipes that use sea products and that elaborate the students of the Training Program in Alternation with the Employment. Artisanal fishing and nautical tourism services are the proposals of the fishing village of Agaete.

Dive lovers can learn about the importance and attractiveness of the protected marine area of El Roque in the hidden area of La Aldea de San Nicolás, which has a unique variety of marine flora and fauna, by the marine currents of the area, which Make it a privileged place to know for the beauty of its submerged orography.
