

The Fotosub Las Palmas de Gran Canaria 2017 presents its poster and heats motors for its tenth edition

The Fotosub Las Palmas de Gran Canaria has a new poster to promote its tenth edition to be held in Las Canteras Beach, from September 21 to 29. The event, an event organized by the Department of City of Mar of the City Council of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria, reinforces the condition of the capital as an ideal destination for the practice of this activity not only for experienced photographers, but also for family enjoyment .

The 2017 poster is a close-up of a beautiful specimen of "Parablennius pilicornis", a barriguda midge also known as moma, common in shallow and rocky areas preferably exposed to waves, even in intertidal zones, Quarries in general and the Charcón area in particular, are shown as perfect habitats. Its morphology has the characteristic shape of the blennids, on the eyes have characteristic short tentacles distinctive elements of this species.

In this case, the photograph, work of the technical director of the test, Enrique Fáber, is a female with an intense orange-yellow coloration. This species has the ability to change its usual color, in gray and light brown tones, males to dark lilac

and females to intense yellow.

"The image shows the spontaneous interaction that takes place between the animal and the photographer," explained the councilor of Ciudad de Mar, José Eduardo Ramírez, adding that he also alludes to the main objective of the event, "to capture diversity and wealth in images Of the marine life that shelters the bay of El Confital, with a great variety of species of fish, algae and invertebrates that inhabit the bottoms of a natural space essential in the life of the city.

For his part, Enrique Faber noted that Las Canteras Beach is "a marine ecosystem where the fauna is very accustomed to human presence. Therefore, the poster is a nod to the balance at the time of living that occurs between bathers and different species.

Fotosub Las Palmas de Gran Canaria has been meaningful over the last decade as a great event for the local public, with more than a thousand people participating in different activities, and a growing attraction for visitors in Las Palmas of Gran Canaria. These data confirm the great interest that underwater photography has in Las Canteras.

The professional competition will again have the Fotosub Nocturno, the Open Fotosub and the Cazafotosub.t.
